
EHC Out-Of-State Abortion

Outreach & Education

As part of our mission toward community education and outreach, EHC offers free workshops, guest speakers, and other educational materials to institutions throughout the Granite State. We work with teachers in local school districts as well as student advocacy groups on college/ university campuses to address the specific needs of discreet student populations. In 2023, we engaged with **9 schools** and districts, amounting to around **1,900 students**.



85% of students who submitted feedback forms in 2023 reported that they learned something new or gained a new perspective from an EHC classroom workshop.


Reproductive Equity Now (REN)
