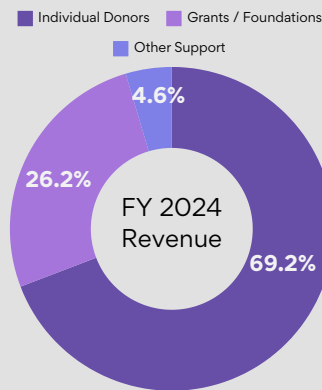

EXPANDED ACCESS

We supported increased clinical training for our on-site provider, and trained 43 residents and students through our partnerships with Dartmouth Health, NHTI and UNH. We also laid the groundwork for our Telehealth program which launched Q1 2025.

PROUD, EQUAL, AND FREE

We celebrated Pride with Granite State families and neighbors at our 1st Annual Pride 5K in Concord, NH, raising \$18k to support our ongoing work in reproductive, sexual, and gender-affirming care for all.

GRATITUDE FOR FOUNDER MOTHERS

We celebrated the courage and tenacity of those who founded our health center in 1974 at our joyful 50th Anniversary Gala, raising \$90k and recentering our work in their beautiful legacy of resiliency, bravery, and compassion.

ADVOCATES FOR CHANGE

Together with our repro coalition allies, we encouraged representatives in the NH House and Senate to vote in support of reproductive rights on 7 major bills. We continue to fight for inclusive legislation through vocal advocacy to keep our community safe and free.

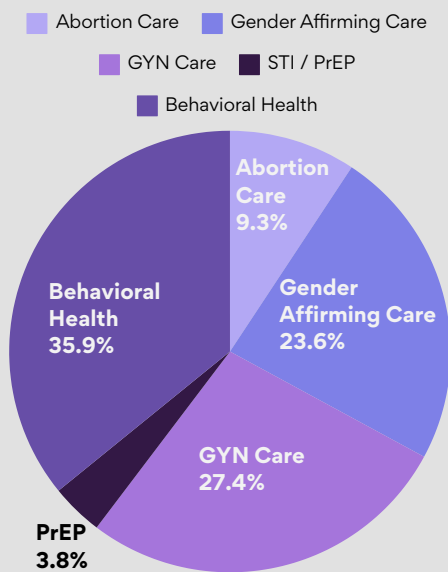
